2021 revenue was below budget \$739,115.90. KWH sales for 2021 were below budget 6,878,318. KW sales ended 2021 above budget 9,628. Reviewed the cost of power for the years 2018 to 2021. The 2021 margin is approximately \$1,618,000.00 prior to Central Power allocation.
